Official Rules

The Basics

- Holiday Hoop-la is a 3 on 3 basketball tournament presented by the Fairview Park Recreation Department.
- Teams will be divided up into 5th/6th grade Boys, 3rd/4th grade Boys, 5th/6th grade girls and 3rd/4th grade girls divisions.
- A maximum of four players may be on a team.
- Teams are asked to come up with a team name.
- Teams will play a “regular season” of at least three games before being seeded for the tournament play. All teams are guaranteed at least four games **(Based on 8 team bracket)**
- The tournament will be single elimination. A maximum of eight teams is allowed in each division.
- The winning teams in each division will receive awards.

The Court

- The baskets will be set at 10 feet.
- Play is 3 on 3, and will run HALF COURT.
- The main baskets will be used.

Game Play

- Score will be kept during the game by the Court Monitor.
- All fouls will be called by the Court Monitor.
- The first team to score 11 points wins; there will be a fifteen minute time limit on the game. Whoever is winning after the time limit will win.
- If the game is tied after the time limit we will go into a sudden death overtime with the first team to score wins.
- A running clock will be used unless the supervisor thinks it's necessary to stop it.
- All games will be played with one point shots and two point shots.
- A shot behind the three point line will count for two points and a shot inside the arc will count as one point.
- The ball must be taken back behind the three point line on every possession. Both player's feet and the basketball must be behind the line.
- On defensive rebounds or steals, players must return the ball by dribble or pass across the three point line before a shot may be attempted. Once across the line, they do not have to pass the ball before shooting.
- On a made basket or any type of stoppage the ball must be “checked” by the defense. The ball must be passed in to a teammate after it is checked.
- Games will be played on a half court, using the main baskets.
- There is no adult coaching of any team.
- There are no time outs. Time will not be stopped to discuss any call.
- Substitutions can be made after a made basket or a stoppage in play. Teams can sub freely and on their own, not at a specific time.
- If a player is fouled in the act of shooting the player will receive one free throw, and the ball will go over to the other team.
- If a player is fouled and is not in the act of shooting, that team will retain possession.
- There will be alternating possession for all held balls. The court monitor will keep track of possession.

Officiating

- The Court Monitor will make all calls in this tournament. There will be one court monitor on each court. If need be, the supervisor will be asked to rule on any decisions.
- Officiating will be liberal, but within the level of skill for the division.
- A court monitor and supervisor decisions are final.

Other Items

- All jewelry (metal and hard plastic hairclips, necklaces, bracelets, watches, rings, etc.) must be removed and given to a parent before they can enter the game.
- Participants may not play with a cast of any kind.
- Recreation staff are not responsible for misplaced items by players and families.
- Street shoes and boots are not allowed on the gym floor.
- ONLY athletic shoes with rubber soles will be permitted on players.
- Game shoes should be changed into prior to entering the gymnasium to avoid water on the gym floor.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the gymnasiums EXCEPT WATER
