Dear Residents –

For the safety of our residents, visitors, and employees from the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the City of Fairview Park will be closing the Fairview Park Senior Center, the Gemini Center, and Bain Cabin beginning **Saturday, March 14, 2020 through Monday, April 13, 2020**. Also beginning Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup> all non-essential events scheduled for the Dunson Room at Fairview Park City Hall are cancelled.

This decision was made based on information provided by, and in consultation with, our public health partners and professionals at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Ohio Department of Health (ODH) and the Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH).

**Senior Center.** All classes, programs, transportation services and lunches at the Center are cancelled beginning Monday, March 16, 2020. The Center will continue to provide services over the phone. Please contact 440-356-4437 for additional information or to schedule a meal pick-up or delivery.

**Recreation Department/Gemini Center.** All recreation programming is suspended beginning Saturday, March 14, 2020 until further notice. Once again, the Gemini Center will be closed beginning Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. All facility rentals at the Gemini Center are cancelled until further notice. If you have any questions about these matters, please contact 440-356-4444.

The closure of the Gemini Center **WILL NOT** affect the March 17, 2020 Primary Election scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. All Ward 2 voters that were previously scheduled to vote at O'Neill Healthcare will vote at the Gemini Center.

**Bain Cabin.** All facility rentals at Bain Cabin are cancelled until further notice. If you have any questions about these matters, please contact 440-356-4444.

The closure of Bain Cabin **WILL NOT** affect the March 17, 2020 Primary Election scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Bain Cabin is the polling location for all of Ward 5.

**Dunson Room.** All non-essential meetings in the Dunson Room are suspended until further notice. If you have any questions about these matters, please contact 440-356-4425.

The closure of the Dunson Room **WILL NOT** affect the March 17, 2020 Primary Election scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. The Dunson Room is the polling location for all of Ward 3.

**City Hall.** City Hall will remain open during regular business hours. Please check the calendar on the City's website for updates on regularly scheduled meetings including City Council meetings.

Any questions about rescheduling, refunds, credits, etc. should be directed to the appropriate Department. We will try our best to accommodate any rescheduling requests to minimize any further inconvenience.

We will continue to monitor the reports and updates from the CDC, ODH and CCBH and consult with them to determine how to proceed and inform you of any changes to City services.
