Hours of Operation

Gemini Center

- Monday – Friday
 - Open 5:30am – 8:00pm
 - 9:00am – 11:00am (High Risk and Age 60+ on the Fitness Floor)
 - Doors Locked at 7:30pm
- Saturday and Sunday
 - Open 8:00am-3:00pm
 - Doors Locked at 2:30pm

Competition and Leisure Pool

- Monday - Friday
 - Lap Swim: 6:00 AM – 7:30 PM
- Saturday and Sunday
 - Lap Swim: 8:00AM – 2:30 PM

Gemini Center Program and Facility Updates starting March 15, 2021:

- New Water Bottle Filling Stations have been installed on the Fitness Floor, Main Hallway and Conference Room Hallway.
- Vaccinated? The CDC recommends that fully vaccinated people continue to wear a well-fitted mask, stay at least 6 feet from people you do not live with, avoid medium and large sized gatherings, etc. Gemini Center mask and social distancing policies will remain in effect for all including those fully vaccinated
- Household Basketball Court Reservations end on Sunday, March 14, 2021.
- Gymnasium courts A & B will be available for open gym during business hours (exception: Gemini Center programming and rentals)

- Minors under the age of 15 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult while in the Gymnasium
- No games. Shooting and drills only
- Must provide own ball
- The Multi-Purpose Gym is available for drop-in recreation (exception: Gemini Center programming and rentals)
 - Minors under the age of 15 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult while in the Multi-Purpose Gym
 - Drop-in participants must provide own equipment
- **Gemini Center Points of Emphasis**
 - **Minor members under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times in the Gemini Center (exception: Leisure Pool)**
 - **Masks must be worn when moving about the Gemini Center unless engaged in exercise activity or in the pool**
 - **Please clean exercise equipment before and after use. 1-wipe is all that is needed to effectively sanitize a machine**

Members

- Per the State of Ohio, face coverings (masks) are required at all times when indoors and not engaged in a strenuous activity
- Face coverings (masks) are to be worn when moving throughout the building and when moving from equipment to equipment while working out
- Members and Patrons that object to or fail to adhere to the Gemini Center face covering (mask) policies will not be permitted to use the facility or participate in our programs
- Individuals with a medical condition including those with respiratory conditions that restrict breathing, mental health conditions or disability are exempt from being required to wear a face covering (mask) but must provide to the front desk a note from their physician documenting that there is a condition that makes the individual exempt. This documentation must be updated every sixty (60) days
- Memberships were automatically extended by actual number of days lost, due to mandated Center closure
- Members only. No guest passes
- Membership renewals permitted
- Members are requested to perform a wellness check (temperature and symptoms) prior to entering
- Do not enter center if exhibiting symptoms
- Maintain appropriate social distancing
- Members are requested to keep socializing to a minimum
- Members are requested to sanitize all equipment prior to use
- Members are required to sanitize all equipment after use

- Members are requested to sanitize hands upon entering building
- Members are requested to regularly wash / sanitize hands
- Members may not share balls or equipment
- Members are required to provide their own balls and equipment

Safety and Sanitization

- Employees must wear masks
- Gloves are available for all employees
- Employees are required to perform a wellness check (temperature and symptoms) prior to entering. If ill, please do not come to work
- Employees are screened (temperature) at the beginning of every shift
- Counter top barriers, social distancing marking, and signage has been installed
- All restrooms and high contact surfaces will be cleaned every 2 hours
- Employees are required to enforce social distancing, capacity limits, and all other state guidelines
- Center will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized on a nightly basis
- Equipment has been spaced to ensure at least 6 feet between each piece
- Disinfectant wipes are available to clean equipment
- Hand washing sinks are available in the restroom and sanitizer stations are located throughout the building
- Employees have been provided instruction on COVID-19 prevention.
- No ceiling fans or floor fans

Confirmed Cases

- Isolate and contact the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for any individual who develops symptoms while at facility
- Shut down space for deep cleaning and sanitizing
- Assist County Board of Health with contact tracing

Facilities Information

- Fitness floor, studio 3, track, Gymnasium, Multi-Purpose Gym and competition/leisure pool open
- Restrooms, family changing rooms and locker rooms open
- Locker Room Policies
 - Lockers in between those available will be disabled
 - Benches will be marked off to show 6-foot social distancing guidelines
 - Locker rooms will be closed and unavailable at posted times for cleaning
 - Members and patrons are asked to leave lockers open after each use for sanitation purposes
 - Showers will be unavailable for use
 - Day lockers in the hallway will remain closed

- All lockers are day use only. Locks left overnight will be cut off and anything left will be disposed of
- Locker rentals will be put on hold
- No Conference Center Rooms
- No Kids Club, sauna, hot tub / spa, pool play feature and slides
- No casual seating or tables
- No equipment, basketballs, racquets or balls will be provided

- Willow Room – 10
- Elevator – 2
- Main Level Restrooms – 3
- Fitness Floor Restrooms - 2

Activities, Services, and Programs

- Personal Fitness Training (by appointment with instructor)
- Pickleball on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8:00am – 12:00pm
 - Members only. 16-member capacity
 - Participants must bring own racquets and balls
 - Masks must be worn unless engaged in activity
- Fitness Equipment
- Track walking / running
- Lap Swimming/ Water walking
- Private Swim lessons (by appointment only)
- Rentals and reservations are subject to change due to FPRD programming
- No Conference Center Room Rentals
- No Silver Sneaker Fitness Classes

- No Adult Fitness Classes
- No Kids Club childcare
- No water fountains. There are bottle filling stations on the main level and fitness floor
- No lost and found

Competition Pool Rules

- We will take reservations for 6 swimmers every hour. Reservations for lane usage will be taken online through the recreation department website and in-person at the front desk
- Reservations for lanes will begin on the hour
- The reservation will include:
 - 45 minutes of lap swimming
 - 15 minutes to clear and sanitize the pool
- Travel light and come ready to go! There is limited space around the deck for belongings
- The locker rooms located in the competition pool will be made available for changing and restroom use only. The showers will be closed
- Only swimmers ages 15 and older are permitted (exception: team/group rentals)
- If you are running a temperature or feeling ill in anyway please stay home
- Members will enter the pool from the double doors. Members will exit the pool from the back door leading to the high school parking lot
- Upon arrival on deck, please find a designated area to put your belongings down and wait for the lifeguards to notify you when you can get in the water
- Please be sure to bring plenty of liquids to drink because the drinking fountains will be closed
- Patrons are expected to remain 6 feet apart from each other with an exception to those in the same household
- Masks are mandatory when entering and exiting the facility and when not involved in an activity, masks are not permitted in the water

Leisure Pool Rules

- Members only. 35 people maximum
- Lifeguards will close entry to pool once the maximum number is reached
- Every 2 hours the staff will deep clean the pool area
- Anyone under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult
- Toys and balls are not permitted
- Kickboards and noodles will not be provided
- Upright chairs will not be supplied. The slides and kiddie attractions will not be operational
- Benches for belongings will be on a first come first serve basis

- Masks are mandatory when entering and exiting the facility and when not involved in an activity
- Masks are not permitted in the water
- The locker rooms located in the competition pool will be made available for changing and restroom use only. The showers will be closed
- The Family changing rooms and restrooms will be available for families and anyone with special needs. Showers will be closed
- Members will enter the pool from the double doors. Members will exit the pool from the back door leading to the high school parking lot
- Only coast guard approved flotation devices are permitted
- Patrons are expected to remain 6 feet apart from each other with an exception to those in the same household
- Please do not come to the pool if you or a family member are feeling ill
