Job Summary:

The Custodian is responsible for the daily cleanliness and representation of the facility. They will conduct
routine cleaning of the various areas of the facility as well as assist with room setups, tear downs and any
special projects that may be assigned.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide a safe and healthy environment for members to participate at The Gemini Center
- Clean locker rooms and restrooms including floors, countertops, mirrors, toilets, lockers, and showers.
- Ensure proper sanitation of building and grounds
- Wet and dry mop and/or scrubbing of floors
- Laundering of towels
- Setup and teardown events in the Community Rooms, Gym, Multipurpose, or other area of the building that are hosting a special events or classes.
- Assist with snow removal and salt distribution around The Gemini Center
- Take out trash and recyclables for facility
- Complete each task assigned in their zone during the specified shift
- Provide availability of no less than 4 weekend (Saturday/Sunday) nights per month. Exceptions must be cleared by management in advance
- Implement, and participate in the Emergency Action Plan to accidents or injuries. Fill out an Accident Report when providing any medical assistance
- Perform other duties as assigned

- Professional appearance and demeanor
- CPR, AED, and First Aid Certified (within 60 days of hire)
